Hand Wreath

MATERIALS

- White paper
 - ALTERNATIVE: construction paper of different colors (ideally green)
- Colorful markers/pens/pencils/crayons (ideally green and red)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Clear tape or glue
- OPTIONAL: string or a bow to hang the wreath

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Trace one of your hands on your paper with your pencil 12 different times (less or more tracings could work but you just need to make sure you have enough to form a circle of hands in the end)
 - a. If you are using different color paper, make sure to trace your hands on different colored papers so your end wreathe can have a variety of colors
- 2. If you are using white paper, color in the traced hands in all different colors (ideally green), adding different designs if you want
- 3. Cut out the hands that you have traced!
 - a. This may need adult help
- 4. Arrange your traced hands in a circle to create a wreath-like circle and tape/glue the hands together!
- 5. Feel free to color in red berries or any other decorations!
- 6. If you have string or a bow go ahead and wrap it through one of the sides of the wreath to allow it to hang up!
- 7. There you have it! Your hand wreath is done!
